**A RESOLUTION HONORING “MORIAH PIE”
IN THE CITY OF NORWOOD, OHIO**

WHEREAS, Moriah Pie was a “pay-as-you-are-able” pizza restaurant located at the Speckled Bird Café on Mills and Carter Avenues, in west Norwood; and

WHEREAS, the ingredients for Moriah Pie were mostly cultivated and grown in and around west Norwood; and

WHEREAS, Moriah Pie was opened in 2012 by Robert and Erin Lockridge and

WHEREAS, Matt Latchaw and Lyric Morris Latchaw having begun volunteering in 2016, were invited to join the crew “full-time” as co-laborers in 2019; and

WHEREAS, many Norwood residents helped cook and serve at the restaurant; and

WHEREAS, Moriah Pie had been a gathering place in west Norwood where many joyous Friday nights were filled with a rare cross-section of community residents; and

WHEREAS, Moriah Pie’s existence led to other community-building ventures like Cooking Camp, Garden Camp, and a breakfast café; and

WHEREAS after nine growing seasons, and eight food service seasons, the team decided it best to close Moriah Pie indefinitely at the end of 2020; and

WHEREAS, in 2021 the team reopened the café for breakfast as the For the Life of the World Cafe, continuing to provide the same community as before but with eggs, cinnamon rolls, and coffee instead of pizza and salad; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City Council thanks and congratulates the Moriah Pie team on a job well done these past nine years,

SECTION 2. The City Council wishes the Moriah Pie team continued success in all their ventures in the City of Norwood.
