RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY AUDITOR TO APPROVE A "THEN AND NOW" CERTIFICATE FOR THE GENERAL FUND PUBLIC LANDS AND BUILDINGS CONTRACTUAL SERVICES 1001-0911-57200 TO COVER THE COST OF AN INVOICE FOR CIVIC PLUS LLC FOR OF \$8,137.50, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Auditor has requested that the Council authorize the Auditor to approve a "Then and Now" certificate for the SeeClickFix annual license/software for a total of \$8,137.50 to cover the cost of an invoice from Civic Plus LLC; and

WHEREAS, the amount of \$8,137.50 exceeds the threshold of \$3,000 that the Auditor, Jim Stith, can approve; and

WHEREAS, the invoice date was July 31, 2022, with a due date of September 30, 2022 and listed as a two-year annual fee in 2021 and was therefore inadvertently left off our annual income list; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City Auditor's office is hereby authorized to approve a "Then and Now" certificate the invoice for a total of \$8,137.50 from **GENERAL FUND PUBLIC LANDS AND BUILDINGS CONTRACTUAL SERVICES 1001-0911-57200** to cover the cost of the invoice from Civic Plus LLC. This certificate shall state that both at the time the contract was made or the purchase order issued (then) and at the time the certificate is executed (now), the amount of the order or contract has been lawfully appropriated for the purpose of the order or contract, that the appropriation remains unencumbered and that resources to pay the obligation when it comes due are on hand or in the process of collection to the credit of **GENERAL FUND PUBLIC LANDS AND BUILDINGS CONTRACTUAL SERVICES 1001-0911-57200**.

SECTION 2. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency resolution and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to proceed forthwith to authorize payment of the invoice from Civic Plus LLC to avoid incurring any late fees and/or penalties on that payment.


