Ordinance No. 71 2020

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO IMPROVE HERITAGE PARK, JUST SOUTH OF THE NORWOOD MUNICIPAL BUILDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Heritage Park, just south of the Norwood Municipal Building in the 4600 block of Montgomery Road, would benefit from the demolition of some hardscape areas and the construction of a new exterior plaza, including the installation of decorative concrete paving, site furnishings, and landscape improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Administration has obtained approval from Hamilton County to use Community Development Block Grants to improve Heritage Park; now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** The Safety Service Director is hereby authorized to advertise for bids to improve Heritage Park, the park just south of the Norwood Municipal Building on Montgomery Road, in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the Safety Service Director and to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder to make the replacement as specified.

**SECTION 2.** The funds for this improvement will be paid directly to the contractor by Hamilton County through its Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, so the contract will not be paid out of City of Norwood funds.


**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to make the improvements to allow park patrons to use the park for eating outdoors, and to otherwise enjoy the use of the park, even during the Covid-19 pandemic.
