Ordinance No. 46 2020

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE INDIAN MOUND STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION PROJECT NO. CB06X/B07X, JMA #4138) WITHIN THE CITY OF NORWOOD, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Council desires to repair and improve Indian Mound Avenue, Parmalee Place and Wakefield Place, including, but not limited to, milling the pavement about 2.5" deep, and overlaying it with asphalt concrete, making deeper pavement repairs, maintaining catch basins for storm water runoff; removing and replacing all curb, replacing all driveway aprons between the curb and the sidewalk, and constructing new curb ramps; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration has determined that the most cost-efficient way for the City to make the repairs and improvements is by collaborating on Ohio Public Works Commission Project No. CB06X/B07X (JMA #4138) under which the OPWC will provide approximately \$1,354,650 of the Project cost, about 91% of the total Project cost of approximately \$1,485,000, and the City of Norwood will provide about \$130,350, of the cost of the Project, about 9% of the total Project cost; now therefore,


**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** The Safety-Service Director is hereby authorized to advertise for bids, and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, for the Indian Mound Street Improvements Project (Ohio Public Works Commission Project No. CB06X/B07X, JMA #4138) pursuant to plans and specifications on file in the office of the Safety-Service Director.

**SECTION 2.** The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay warrants for the foregoing purpose out of **FUND 46-CAPITAL PROJECTS** and **FUND 5-PERMISSIVE TAX**.


**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to implement this street improvement project that improves the health and safety of the City of Norwood.


