Ordinance No. 47 20 2020

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS, AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR 2020 PAVING IMPROVEMENTS TO CATHEDRAL AVENUE AND SHANMOOR AVENUE (JMA #4191) WITHIN THE CITY OF NORWOOD, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council desires to improve Cathedral Avenue from Carthage Avenue to Fenwick Avenue, including targeted full depth pavement repairs (exact locations determined in field during construction), curb ramp upgrades, milling the existing pavement 2.5" deep, overlaying 2.5" of new asphalt, and pavement markings; and

WHEREAS, Council also desires to improve Shanmoor Avenue from Floral Avenue to Catherine Avenue, including targeted full depth pavement repairs (exact locations determined in field during construction), curb ramp upgrades, milling the existing pavement 2.5" deep, overlaying 2.5" of new asphalt, and pavement markings; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration has been advised by its consulting engineers that the City will realize some savings, due to an economy of scale on the costs, if the projects are combined into a single contract and by completing the paving by the end of October to avoid late fall weather in which it is difficult to work; now, therefore,


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. the Service-Safety Director is authorized to advertise for sealed bids, based upon the plans and specifications on file in his office, to accept sealed bids to complete the project pursuant to those plans and specifications, to open those bids, and to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for paving and other improvements to Cathedral Avenue and to Shanmoor Avenue (JMA#4191); and

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay warrants for the foregoing purpose out of **02-STREET FUND AND FUND 46-CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS**.



This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the need to complete a street improvement project that improves the health and safety of the City of Norwood.


