Ordinance No. 38 2020

ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING NORWOOD AGENCY FUND 96 "NORWOOD CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND", AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio Legislature recently passed House Bill 481, "Authorize conveyance of state-owned real property" that is currently awaiting signature by Governor DeWine; and

WHEREAS, Section 27(E) provides that money received by a municipality under the provisions of H.B. 481 "shall be deposited into a new fund in the subdivision's treasury to be named the local coronavirus relief fund"; and

WHEREAS, H.B. 481 further provides that funds placed in said Fund "shall be used to cover only costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act," as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and in accordance with the provisions of H.B. 481; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. There is created a special fund for the City of Norwood to be known as the **NORWOOD AGENCY FUND 96, NORWOOD CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND**. Funds received under the terms of H.B. 481, shall be deposited into this fund, and shall be disbursed by the City of Norwood in accordance with the terms of section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 601(d) and H.B. 481.


SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to be eligible to receive federal funds to offset expenses related to the City's response to the Coronavirus pandemic as soon as those funds become available.


