Ordinance No. 29 2020

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF AN ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF APPORTIONING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT FUND

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5747.53 provides that in lieu of apportioning the undivided local government fund by the method prescribed by Revised Code Sections 5747.51 and 5747.52, that a alternative method of apportioning said fund may be approved by the Budget Commission upon approval of such alternative method by the Board of County Commissioners, the legislative authority of the city, located wholly or partially in the county, with the greatest population; and a majority of the boards of township trustees and legislative authorities of municipal corporations, located wholly or partially within the county, excluding the legislative authority of the city with the greatest population; and

WHEREAS, up until 1989, the Hamilton County Budget Commission had operated under the statutory formula provided by Revised Code Sections 5747.51 and 5747.52; and

WHEREAS, the statutory method of apportioning the Fund had resulted in repeated and continued litigation between, and among, the parties entitled to participate in the distribution of the Fund; and

WHEREAS, the statutory method of apportioning the Fund had resulted in continued uncertainties about the financial distribution of the Fund; and

WHEREAS, the alternative method of apportioning the Fund first adopted in 1988 and renewed in 1995, 2004, and again in 2012 has brought stability to the process by eliminating the uncertainties of litigation and providing for a more efficient and effective method of financial planning; and

WHEREAS, the alternative method of apportioning the Local Government Fund as described and outlined in the attached **Exhibit A** represents a fair and equitable method of apportioning the Local Government Fund, which is in the best interests of The City of Norwood;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1. The City of Norwood, Hamilton County, Ohio adopts the attached agreement, incorporated by reference herein as "Exhibit A"

SECTION 2. The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance and to send it forthwith to the office of Hamilton County Budget Commission, Ohio.






