Ordinance No. 22 2019

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR TO APPROVE A "THEN AND NOW" CERTIFICATE FOR THE BUILDING ASSESSMENT FUND (81) TO COVER THE COST OF AN INVOICE FROM THE OHIO BOARD OF BUILDING STANDARDS FOR 2018 FOR A TOTAL OF \$10,282.14, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City Auditor has requested that the Council authorize the Auditor to approve a "Then and Now" certificate for 2018 for a total of \$10,282.14 for The Building Assessment Fund (81) to cover the cost of an invoice from the State of Ohio Board of Building Standards; and

WHEREAS, the Building Assessment Fund (81) is a pass-through fund used for the collection of a percentage of building department fees to be paid to the State of Ohio, and the fund has already been appropriated monies for this invoice; and,

WHEREAS, at a public meeting, the Council's Finance Committee has considered and recommended approval of the Auditor's request; now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** The City Auditor's office is hereby authorized to approve a "Then and Now" certificate for 2018 for a total of \$10,282.14 for **THE BUILDING ASSESSMENT FUND (81)** to cover the cost of the invoice from the State of Ohio Board of Building Standards. This certificate shall state that both at the time the contract was made or the purchase order issued (then) and at the time the certificate is executed (now), the amount of the order or contract has been lawfully appropriated for the purpose of the order or contract, that the appropriation remains unencumbered and that resources to pay the obligation when it comes due are on hand or in the process of collection to the credit of **THE BUILDING ASSESSMENT FUND (81)**.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to proceed forthwith to authorize payment of the invoice from the State of Ohio Board of Building Standards for 2018 to avoid incurring any late fees and/or penalties on that payment.


