

Resolution No. 2 2020

**RESOLUTION DECLARING CITY PERSONAL PROPERTY TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY, AND AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF THAT PROPERTY, CONSISTENT WITH THE CONTRACT WITH HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO**

**WHEREAS**, The City of Norwood has statutory authority under R.C. § 721.15 to dispose of personal property found by the Council to be unneeded, obsolete or unfit ("Surplus") for municipal purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, R.C. § 9.482 authorizes the City of Norwood to contract with another political subdivision to render any service or perform any function which the City of Norwood is authorized by law to perform; and

**WHEREAS**, the Administrative Services Division of Hamilton County, Ohio provides services to other political subdivisions in Hamilton County in auctioning government Surplus personal property; and

**WHEREAS**, by the authority of Ordinance No. 8-2020, the City of Norwood has entered into a contract with Hamilton County allowing Hamilton County to dispose of personal property which the City of Norwood determines to be Surplus property through Hamilton County's Internet Surplus Auction web address: [www.HamiltonCountyOhioAuction.com](http://www.HamiltonCountyOhioAuction.com); and

**WHEREAS**, the City Administration has determined that certain personal property owned by the City is obsolete by its age and condition and unfit for the use for which it has been acquired and has no value to the City of Norwood, other than to be salvaged through its contract with Hamilton County, Ohio, and, therefore is Surplus property;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio that:


**SECTION 1.** Council, upon recommendation of the Administration, declares the personal property owned by the City and listed and described in the attached Exhibit A, to be obsolete by its age and condition, unneeded, and unfit for the uses for which it has been acquired, and therefore Surplus property for municipal purposes, to be disposed of consistent with the terms of the Contract through Hamilton County, Ohio, with any proceeds received by the City from the sale of the Surplus property to be deposited into the City of Norwood's General Fund.


