Ordinance No. 10 20 22

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH NEPTUNE EQUIPMENT COMPANY AS LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, FOR THE “NORWOOD WATER METER REPLACEMENT AND INTEGRATION PROJECT”, INCLUDING REMOTE READ AND DATA COLLECTION SOFTWARE AND HARDWARE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 32-2021, passed June 22, 2021, Council authorized the Safety-Service Director to advertise for bids to update and improve the water meters in the City of Norwood and the current method of collecting the readings from the meters; and to update and improve the software and hardware used to collect, enter, store, and maintain the customers’ account information and readings; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance #47-2021, passed September 14, 2021, the Safety-Service Director, had been authorized to enter into a contract with Neptune Equipment Company for \$2,040,000.00, the acceptance period for that bid expired, the project was rebid, and the lowest and best bidder was Neptune Equipment Company, with a new lowest and best bid of \$2,064,528.49, now, therefore,


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. the Safety-Service Director is authorized to enter into a contract with Neptune Equipment Company as the lowest and best bidder, consistent with its bid, after the opening of sealed bids for the Norwood Water Meter Replacement and system integration project.

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay warrants for the foregoing purpose in the amount of \$2,064,528.49 out of **THE AMERICAN RECOVERY ACT FUND-2095**.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the need to complete a water meter replacement and integration of the replacement of that hardware into the City’s public services billing with this project that will improve the health and safety of the City of Norwood.




