

Ordinance No. 35 2021

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A 60 MONTH CONTRACT, UNDER THE STATE BID PURCHASE PROGRAM, WITH CINCINNATI BELL TELEPHONE, LLC FOR CERTAIN TELEPHONE SERVICE, EQUIPMENT, AND INTERNET SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Norwood needs to update its current telephone system, equipment, internet services, maintenance contract, and connectivity between all city buildings; and

**WHEREAS**, the 60-month contract will include certain upgrades to the current telephone system, connectivity, 24/7 management/monitoring, service response for outages, and internet service, by changing from our current service provider; and

**WHEREAS**, Norwood City Council desires to acquire reliable telephone equipment and services for all city facilities; now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** The Safety-Service Director is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Cincinnati Bell Telephone., in accordance with the proposal on file in the office of the Safety Service Director for installation of a new telephone system and technical support services, (as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein).

**SECTION 2.** The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw, and the City Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay warrants in the amount not to exceed six thousand, nine hundred sixty dollars and forty-eight cents (\$6,960.48) per month for sixty months and a one-time charge of six thousand, six hundred fifty-four dollars and eighty-three cents (\$6,654.83) for the foregoing purpose out of the GENERAL FUND.


**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Norwood and shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
