ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RUSH TRUCK CENTER FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) FORD 2022 F-750 DUMP TRUCK, OUTFITTED WITH THE PROPER EQUIPMENT, FOR USE BY THE NORWOOD PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Norwood Public Works Department requires a new dump truck to better serve its citizens, and its employees in the performance of their duties; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:


SECTION 1. Having received the City of Norwood Financial Planning and Supervision Commission's approval of this purchase as part of the City of Norwood's Financial Plan, the Director of Public Safety-Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Rush Truck Center, in accordance with specifications filed in the office of the Director of Public Safety-Service and/or the Auditor's Office for the purchase of one (1) 2022 Ford F-750 dump truck outfitted with the proper equipment for use by the Norwood Public Works Department. The cost of the dump truck is as follows:

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and the City Treasurer is authorized to pay warrants in the amounts and according to the schedule, as outlined in the attached Exhibit A, for the purchase of the aforementioned vehicle, \$96,553.04 out of the **WATER FUND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT 5050-0853-57600.**


