

Ordinance No. 72 2021

ORDINANCE DECLARING THAT CARTHAGE AVENUE, BETWEEN LAWN AVENUE AND ROSS AVENUE, SHALL HEREBY RECEIVE THE HONORARY, SECONDARY NAME OF "FIRE LIEUTENANT ROBERT PLOGMAN WAY"

WHEREAS, Fire Fighter Robert Plogman was appointed to the Norwood Fire Department on July 26, 1969; and

WHEREAS, Fire Fighter Robert Plogman, then age 35, on June 22, 1980, was activated from off duty to respond to a fire at 5146 Carthage Avenue, as another Norwood Fire unit was fighting another fire on Hopkins Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Fire Fighter Robert Plogman was operating on the aerial ladder when the ladder came in contact with high-voltage electrical power lines and Fire Fighter Plogman was electrocuted; and

WHEREAS, Fire Fighter Bobby Plogman, who was born and raised in Norwood, graduated from Purcell High School, served in the United States Navy from 1965 to 1969 in the Frogman Division, and lived at 2237 Cathedral Avenue with his wife, Jackie, and two daughters, Emily and Mary Anne; and

WHEREAS, Fire Fighter Robert Plogman, who had taken and passed the Fire Lieutenant's promotional exam, was posthumously promoted to Fire Lieutenant; and

WHEREAS, Norwood City Council now wishes to honor Fire Lt. Robert Plogman's brave sacrifice, and that of his family, and to honor the service and sacrifice of all Norwood Fire Fighters, past and present; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Norwood hereby declare that Carthage Avenue, between Lawn Avenue and Ross Avenue, shall hereby receive the honorary, secondary name of "Fire Lt. Robert Plogman Way" by legislative action of the Mayor and City Council in honor of Fire Lt. Robert Plogman, in recognition of his contributions to the City of Norwood.

SECTION 2. That the appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to do all things necessary and proper to implement the provisions of Section 1 herein, including the generation and installation of secondary street signage for Carthage Avenue at its intersections with Lawn Avenue, and Ross Avenue, in accordance with the Department of Transportation and Engineering's procedures relating to secondary street designation and related signage.

SECTION 3. Council also requests that appropriate signs be placed, and an appropriate ceremony conducted on June 22, 2022, at the intersection of Carthage and Lawn Avenues.


SECTION 4. Council declares that June 22 be recognized as Fire Lt. Robert Plogman Day each year.


