



Ordinance No. 59 2021

**ORDINANCE RE-ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS,
EFFECTIVE IN THE YEARS 2022, AND 2024**

WHEREAS, Prior Councils, having last increased the salaries of elected officials in December, 1998 by Ordinance 83-1998, and having cut those same salaries in March, 2003 by 10 percent (10%) and eliminating benefits, by Ordinance 16-2003; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 731.07, prohibits increasing or diminishing of the salary of any officer of a city during the term for which he or she was elected or appointed; and

WHEREAS, after 23 years, Council now desires to re-establish the salaries for elected officials in the City of Norwood, originally established in 1998, as Ohio law allows; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That effective January 1, 2022, the annual salaries of the following elected officials are re-established as follows:

Council Members.....	\$8,500.00
President of Council.....	\$10,500.00
Treasurer.....	\$26,500.00

SECTION 2. That effective January 1, 2024, the annual salaries of the following elected officials are re-established as follows:

Mayor.....	\$36,500.00
Auditor.....	\$26,500.00
Law Director.....	\$26,500.00

SECTION 3. That, effective January 1, 2025, and continuing thereafter, the salaries set forth above shall automatically be increased each year by the average percentage of increase in the consumer price index for the twelve-month period that ends on the thirtieth day of September of the immediately preceding year, rounded to the nearest one-tenth of one per cent. "Consumer price index" for this purpose shall mean the index, as prepared by the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics (U.S. city average for urban wage earners and clerical workers: all items 1982-1984=100), or, if that index is no longer published, a generally available comparable index.

SECTION 4. That the Mayor, Auditor, Law Director, Treasurer, President of Council and Councilmembers, remain ineligible to receive all benefits, except Ohio Public Employee Retirement System (OPERS) benefits.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall supersede any other ordinance and/or parts thereof that are in conflict with this ordinance.
